Section 4: Restrictions of the Scholarships

To qualify for a Mighty Mites Scholarship or Mighty Mites Cheer Leading Scholarship, the applying Senior must have participated in at least one year of West Plains Optimist Mighty Mites Football or Cheer Leading. The General Scholarship is open to all area High School Seniors.

If for some reason the scholarship winner does not follow through with attending college, the winner **must** notify the Optimist Club as soon as possible so the runner up can be notified and receive the scholarship.

Upon enrolling for the fall semester, the winner will be eligible to receive a check for \$500 to be applied to tuition, books, etc. Upon enrolling for the spring semester, the winner will eligible to receive another \$500 check; however, if the student maintains a B average or higher in the fall semester, the second check will be in the amount of \$750.
