## RULES:

- Fishing will be for registered participants only; parents are not allowed to fish for the child (casting is permitted).
- Tournament will start at 8am and end at 11:30 am
- Once your child has caught a fish, unhook and place in the 5-gallon bucket provided, one of the members will come by to weigh and release the fish back in the lake
- Winners for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place are determined by the accumulative weight of all fish caught.
- Big Fish goes to the child with the largest fish caught.
