



# T-Ball Rules

1. Can not guarantee team placement
  - A. We do our best to accommodate
  - B. There will be no “switching teams” once season has begun
2. Each team will have One Head Coach and One Assistant Coach
  - A. if one coach or the other is unavailable, for any reason, then the Head Coach  
May choose a substitute for that day.
  - B. Team shirts will be provided to the Head Coach and Assistant Coach. Only  
two coach shirts per team, per year.
3. No one other than Umpires, Coaches and Players are allowed on the field during a game.
  - A. If an injury occurs, one parent/guardian may enter the field to retrieve their  
child and exit the field.
  - B. Exceptions may be made if the child is handicapped. Please speak with  
Program Chairman about your situation.
4. EVERYONE PLAYS! No Exceptions!
5. Games are two innings, not to go over 45 minutes.
6. Player gets 3 swings before a coach must assist.
7. Inning is finished when entire line-up for both teams has batted.
8. Coaches inform umpire of “last batter”.
9. Ball is considered foul if it doesn't reach the “pitcher”.
10. Play is over when attempt to return ball to “pitcher” and umpire calls “time”.
11. At end of game, players line up and shake hands.

## Coaches And Parents

T-ball is designed to introduce children to baseball and softball. Learning the fundamentals and preparing them for the older programs is our 2nd concern. Our #1 concern is for everyone to Have Fun!

We will not tolerate foul language, consumption of alcoholic beverages, smoking/vaping, or violence of any kind at our events and programs. If you are found doing so, you will be asked to leave without warning.

Each child will receive a team shirt prior to the first game and medals after the last game.
